

A Message from Brent Whiteside, Executive Vice President



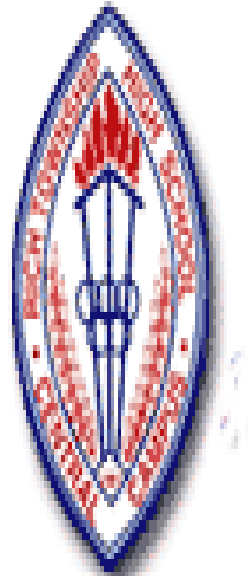
