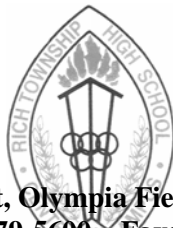

Re: Athletic/Activity Eligibility

Starting second quarter 2006, it will be the policy of Rich Township High School to require all students who wish to participate in extra-curricular activities to have earned at least a 2.0 ("C") grade point average during the grading period immediately preceding athletic participation. A student who fails to earn at least a 2.0 grade average may not participate in extra-curricular activities, including all athletic teams.

Weekly Eligibility Requirements

1. Students who meet that requirement but who have **1 or 2 "D/F's" in courses will be subject to the following remediation**
 - a. Student with one "D/F" will continue to play in games and participate in practices.
 - b. Student with two "D/F's" will continue to practice only.
 - c. Coach / sponsor notification of failure(s).
 - d. Parental notification of failure(s).
 - e. Counselor notification of failure(s).
 - f. Required tutorials/study table to remove failing grades.
 1. The student must attend a 1-hour, supervised study table three days per week. The study table is held from 7:10 am until 8:10 or 3:20 p.m. until 4:20 p.m. in the Room 114.
 2. The student must attend all student table sessions (NO UNEXCUSED ABSENCES)!
 3. The student must complete and show evidence of completing school work during the student session.
 - g. *Parent conference for students who fail 2 or more courses in one week.*

Your current academic status, probation for first quarter 2006/2007 or not having met the weekly eligibility requirements needed to participate, requires you to participate in the Rich Central study table program in order to remain eligible for your athletic or activity team. You are to report to the Room 114 for athletic study table at 7:15 a.m. or 3:15 p.m. beginning on _____.

Study table attendance is an on-going requirement for you, ending only after you have obtained a 2.0 or better grade average in the future; or, if your involvement with extra-curricular activities terminates. Study table attendance is excused only if you have an excused absence approved by the Deans' Office (illness, for example). Every Friday I will notify your coach of your eligibility status. Don't let yourself or your team down — stay eligible! Be at study table on time!

Our study table tutors are there to help you with your education. They may ask to see your homework and may talk with your teachers. Bring books and materials to study table. Mr. Bozeman and/or other staff members will be happy to help you with homework if you need assistance. Just like the tutors provided by universities for their athletes, Rich Central study table will be using the same format. We want you to be eligible to play sports, but the Athletic Department and your coaches feel even stronger that getting a good education is the most important task facing you. Comply with the study table rules and you will be able to play sports and get help with your education. **Don't forget, your study table obligation starts this coming Tuesday, _____.** You must attend at all of the study sessions each week to be eligible for the next week. **BE THERE!**
